Jesus promises that His disciples would not be left alone but that He would send them another **ADVOCATE**.

Acts 19:2 "We haven't heard that there is even a Holy Spirit."

Principles On Holy Spirit

I. The **PERSONALITY** of the Holy Spirit

A. The spirit is not an **IT**.

Romans 8:16

B. The Holy Spirit is a **PERSON**.

C. The Holy Spirit is endowed with:

1. **VOLITION**

2. **EMOTION**

Three essentials for
a personality

3. **KNOWLEDGE**

II. The **PRIORITY** of the Holy Spirit

A. "I will pray the Father and He will give you **ANOTHER**
Comforter," vs. 16

1. Two words in Greek for *another* are:

- The word **HETEROS** which means 'another of a different kind'
- The other word is **ALLOS** which means
'the exact same kind of substance'

(over)

III. The **PRIORITY** of the Holy Spirit

A. He comes to **PROMOTE** Jesus Christ vs. 13-14

B. He comes to **PROVIDE** strength for Christian living
*"I will send you another **COMFORTER**"*

1. Comforter – is a **LATIN** word

- *com* means **WITH**
- *fortata* means **FORTRESS**
- so the word means **WITH STRENGTH**

C. Holy Spirit comes to **PRAY** for us

1. The word for comforter in the Greek is the word **PARA KLETE**
Two words: *Para* means **ALONGSIDE**
Kaleo means **TO CALL**

2. Someone **CALLED ALONGSIDE** to help

3. The word *para klete* in Greek is the word **ADVOCATE**

IV. The **PERMANANCY** of the Holy Spirit. vs. 16

A. The Holy Spirit will be **IN** (vs. 17) you **FOREVER**
